STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Establish Program Budgeting for Counties and to Require Submission of the County Estimates to the Secretary of State by the 20th Day of each January in which the Legislature Meets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 252-A is enacted to read:

§ 252-A. Program budgeting

All counties shall prepare estimates under section 252 in a program budget format and shall submit these estimates to the Secretary of State under section 253 in a program budget format.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the counties to develop budget estimates in a program budget format rather than in the current line item budget format usually used, in order to allow a more comprehensive review of county budget estimates.
