COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1299, L.D. 1575, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Licensing and Fee Requirements for Private
Detective, Watch, Guard or Patrol Agencies."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Clarify
the Definition of Watch, Guard or Patrol Agency.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'32 MRSA §3803, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 582, §1,
is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The phrase "business of" as used in this section shall
not be interpreted to require the obtaining of a license in
compliance with this chapter by any state, county or local law
enforcement officer who engages in that type of activity
regulated by this chapter on a part-time, off-duty basis.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment inserts in place of the present provisions
of the bill a clarification of the existing law regarding the
definition of "business of" as it relates to a person in the
business of providing watch, guard or patrol agency service.
