STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Period for Commencing Civil Actions under the Human Rights Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 4613, sub-§ 2, ¶ C, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 501, § 1, is amended to read:
- C. The action shall be commenced not more than one 3 year years after the act of unlawful discrimination complained of.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to lengthen the period within which the Human Rights Commission must commence a civil action in the Superior Court so that the commission will have an adequate period to exhaust all possibilities for success of informal means of eliminating unlawful discrimination prior to going to court.
