HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1309, L.D. 1588, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Near the
Augusta Exit to Indicate the City of Hallowell."

Amend said Bill in the title by inserting at the end
before the punctuation the following: 'and to Provide for
Signs Denoting "The Maine Gold Star Memorial Highway"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'23 MRSA §1201, sub-§§ 26 and 27 are enacted to read:'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'27. The Maine Gold Star Memorial Highway. Two signs
shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike,
one within 1,000 feet of the Kittery entrance to the Maine
Turnpike and one within 1,000 feet of the Gardiner interchange.
These signs shall contain the words "The Maine Gold Star
Memorial Highway" and other appropriate wording in accordance
with the Resolves of 1965, chapter 31.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires the erection of 2 signs on the
Maine Turnpike noting the designation of the turnpike from
Kittery to the Gardiner exchange as the Maine Gold Star
Memorial Highway, which was made by the Legislature in the
Resolves of 1965, chapter 31.
