STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT to Establish a Sign on the Maine Turnpike Near the Augusta Exit
to Indicate the City of Hallowell.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

23 MRSA § 1201, sub-§ 26 is enacted to read:

26. City of Hallowell. This sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike within 1,000 feet north of the Augusta Exit and shall be worded as follows :

EXIT FOR CITY OF HALLOWELL

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes a sign on the Maine Turnpike near the Augusta exit to indicate the City of Hallowell as a recreational area. Hallowell is one of the national centers for the sale of antiques and is often sought out by tourists who are visiting Maine. As the turnpike is one of the routes most commonly used by tourists, there should be a sign near the proper exit indicating the route to Hallowell.
