SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1590, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Utility Rate-making Treatment of Certain Advertising and Sales Promotion Expenses of Electrical Companies."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§51-A." in the 8th line (6th line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "customers" the underlined words 'of matters affecting their service and rates,' and in the 12th, 13th and 14th lines (10th and 11th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", expenses tending to promote the construction of nuclear generating facilities or the power generated thereby"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent electrical companies from being penalized for informing their customers as to matters affecting their rates and service and for keeping their customers informed with respect to a major source of power generation.
