COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1307, L.D. 1591, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Provide for One Representative of the Fishing

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the word  
"Industry" the words 'and One Representative of the Agricultural  
Industry'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th line  
(4th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "11" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined figure '12'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined  
word "State" in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) the following:  
'and one of whom shall represent the agricultural industry of  
the State'
