STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for One Representative of the Fishing Industry on the Board of Environmental Protection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

38 MRSA § 361, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 618, § 9, is amended to read:

The Board of Environmental Protection, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this subchapter called the "board," shall consist of ± 0 II members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, 2 of whom shall represent manufacturing interests of the State, one of whom shall represent the fishing industry of the State, 2 of whom shall be representatives of municipalities, 2 of whom shall represent the public generally, 2 of whom shall represent the conservation interests in the State and 2 other members knowledgeable in matters relating to air pollution, and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection ex officio.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to add one representative of the fishing industry to the Board of Environmental Protection. This bill will thus enlarge the representation of the Board by adding the representative of a major industry in the State.
