COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1293, L.D. 1600, Bill,
"AN ACT to Improve the Enforcement of the Federal Flammable
Fabrics Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'26 MRSA c. 5, sub-c. I-B is enacted to read:

SUBCHAPTER I-B
FLAMMABLE FABRICS

§136. Liaison for Federal Flammable Fabrics Act

The Bureau of Labor shall serve as a liaison to the United
States Consumer Product Safety Commission, act as a channel of
information between the Federal Government and the citizens of
Maine concerning federal laws on consumer products with emphasis
on flammable fabrics and children's sleepwear and promote public
awareness of federal flammable fabrics legislation and enforcement.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the Bureau of
Labor the liaison with the Federal Government, rather than the
Bureau of Consumer Protection. The Bureau of Labor already deals
with similar problems of product safety.
