COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1301, L.D. 1602, Bill,
"AN ACT to Require the Carrying of a Concealed Weapons License
when a Concealed Weapon is Carried."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2031, first ¶, as enacted by PL 1967,
c. 368, is amended by adding before the last sentence the
following:
'Every licensee shall have his license in his immediate
possession at all times when carrying a concealed weapon
and shall display the same upon demand of any law enforcement
officer. No person charged with failure to have his license
in his immediate possession while carrying a concealed weapon
shall be convicted if he produces in court an operator's
license theretofore issued to him and valid at the time of
the issuance of a court summons. If the person so charged
shall exhibit to a law enforcement officer designated by the
summonsing officer such a license not later than 24 hours before
the time set for the court appearance, then the complaint shall
not be issued.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to model the bill being
amended after section 531-B of Title 29 which relates to the
carrying and exhibiting on demand of^a motor vehicle operator's
license.
