AN ACT Relating to Environmental Controls and the Sardine Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

32 MRSA § 4162 is enacted to read:

§ 4162. State and local regulations

Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, no state agency or municipality of this State may impose any environmental rule, regulation, law or ordinance on any segment of the sardine industry which is more stringent than federal law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to require all environmental requirements imposed upon the sardine industry be no more stringent than required by the Federal Government.
