HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 476, L.D. 1609, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Job Development, Placement and Follow-up Services in Secondary Schools."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services the sum of \$1,000,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
