STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of the East Auburn Community Unit, Inc.,
from Property Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

East Auburn Community Unit, Inc.; exempt from taxes. The real estate and personal property owned and occupied or used solely for its own purposes by the East Auburn Community Unit, Inc., a nonprofit Maine corporation, shall be exempt from taxation.

FISCAL NOTE

Passage of this Act will have no discernible effect on state revenue.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to exempt the East Auburn Community Unit, Inc., from payment of real and personal property taxes.
