COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.1338, L.D.  
1624, Bill "AN ACT to Correct Technical Errors  
in Laws Relating to Marine Resources."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking  
out all of that part designated "§3403." and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'§3403. The applicability of the marine resources  
law generally

All general laws of Maine fixing or regulating  
the minimum or maximum sizes of fish, shellfish  
or lobsters, regulating fishing methods, quantity  
and types of gear, regulating or prohibiting the  
sale, transportation or possession of fish,  
shellfish or lobsters, shall apply to all persons  
conducting the activities so regulated or  
prohibited where such activities or any portion  
thereof are conducted within the State of Maine,  
within the territorial waters of the State of  
Maine, or the product of such activities are  
brought into the State or into the territorial  
waters of the State, and shall apply to all  
residents of the State of Maine where such  
activities are conducted within waters adjacent to  
the territorial waters of Maine and under the  
jurisdiction of the United States but not another  
state.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment implements the original intent  
of the bill.
