STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Correct Technical Errors in Laws Relating to Marine Resources.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 3403, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 508, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 3403. The applicability of the marine resources law generally

All general laws of Maine fixing or regulating the minimum or maximum sizes of fish, shellfish or lobsters, regulating fishing methods, quantity and types of gear, regulating or prohibiting the sale, transportation or possession of fish, shellfish or lobsters, shall apply to all persons conducting the activities so regulated or prohibited where such activities are conducted either within the State of Maine, within the territorial waters of the State of Maine, within the waters under the jurisdiction of the United States but not another state, or the product of such activities are brought into the State or into the territorial waters of the State or any portion of the activities so regulated or prohibited take place within the State.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1959, c. 155, § 132 is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

These amendments to existing law are intended to correct technical inconsistencies and redundancies in the law.
