COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1353, L.D. 1630, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Dogs."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 5th and 12th lines enacting clause after the / (4th and 10th lines in L.D.) the underlined figure "5" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '7'

Fiscal Note

This amendment will save the State approximately \$24,000 instead of the \$40,000 stated in the fiscal note of the original bill.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to protect the public by adding 2 days to the retention period that is established in the original bill. Members of the public indicated that 5 days was too short a period at times for people to obtain their lost dogs.
