SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1308, L.D. 1651, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Maine State  
Ferry Advisory Board."

Amend said Amendment by striking out in the last line  
of the first paragraph the underlined figure "4" and inserting  
in place thereof the underlined figure '3'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the  
first paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out  
all of that part designated "§4302." and inserting in place  
thereof the following:

§4302. Membership

The membership of the board shall consist of one person  
from each of the island municipalities and plantations serviced  
by the Maine State Ferry System and 3 members appointed by the  
Commissioner of Transportation. The members representing the  
island municipalities and plantations shall be appointed by the  
officers or selectmen of the member's municipality or by the  
assessors of the member's plantation and all members shall serve  
a term of office of 2 years. Vacancies in membership shall be  
filled in the same manner as the original appointment.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part  
designated "§4304." of section 4 and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

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§4304. Duties

The board shall advise the Department of Transportation on matters relating to the Maine State Ferry Service and shall submit to the Commissioner of Transportation an annual report which shall include recommendations for change to the Maine State Ferry Service and comments upon the present and future needs of that service. Written reports and comments shall be available to the public.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment increases the membership of the board, establishes a minimum of 3 meetings a year and allows the board greater flexibility in administering its duties.
