

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "<sup>A</sup>" to H.P. 1358, L.D. 1660, Bill, "AN ACT to Extend the Hours for Sale of Liquor During the Tourist Season."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 2, 3 and 4 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. 28 MRSA §4, 4th ¶, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 500, §4-A, is further amended to read:

Licensed hotels, class A restaurants and clubs, as defined under section 2, shall have the right to sell liquor on Sundays between the hours of 12 noon and midnight and, during the period from May 1st to September 30th of each year, on Sundays from midnight until 2 a. m. and from noon until midnight and continuing into Monday until 2 a. m., and such sales may be made during such time by the licensee himself, a clerk, servant or agent in a municipality or unincorporated place where a majority of votes cast in the municipality or unincorporated place in a state-wide special election shall answer in the affirmative to the following local option guestion:

Sec. 3. 28 MRSA §4, 6th ¶, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 196, §1, is amended to read:

Licensees who are licensed to sell malt liquors in retail stores not to be consumed on the premises shall have the right to sell malt liquors for off-premise consumption on Sunday between the hours of 12 noon and midnight and, during the period from May 1st to September 30th of each year, on Sundays from midnight until 2 a. m. and from noon until midnight and continuing into Monday until 2 a. m., and such sales

may be made during such time by the licensee himself, a clerk, servant or agent in a municipality or unincorporated place where a majority of votes cast in the municipality or unincorporated place in a general election shall answer in the affirmative to the following local option question:

Sec. 4. 28 MRSA §4, 8th ¶, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 196, §1, is amended to read:

Licensees who are licensed to sell table wines in retail stores not to be consumed on the premises shall have the right to sell table wines for off-premise consumption on Sunday between the hours of 12 noon and midnight and, during the period from May 1st to September 30th of each year, on Sundays from midnight until 2 a. m. and from noon until midnight and continuing into Monday until 2 a. m., and such sales may be made during such time by the licensee himself, a clerk, servant or agent in a municipality or unincorporated place where a majority of votes cast in the municipality or unincorporated place in a general election shall answer in the affirmative to the following local option question:'

This amendment ensures consistency among the various provisions concerning Sunday sales which are contained in the bill.
