SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1361, L.D. 1663, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Termination of Utility Service."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

> 'A. In the case of a water company or water district, the amount owing is more than a bill for 3 months' service and in the case of any other utility if the amount owing is more than \$30; and B. The utility terminates service no less than 60 days from the commencement date of the customer's

billing period, and no less than 22 days from the date the customer was advised that his or her account was due and payable.'

The purpose of this amendment is to revise provisions of the committee amendment relating to termination of utility services.
