SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1485, L.D. 1677,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Law Relating to Group  
Insurance Certificates."


Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out  
all of the first sentence of that part designated  
"§2821." and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
ing:

'Except in the case of blanket health insurance,  
a provision that the insurer shall issue to the  
policyholder, for delivery to each member of the  
insured group, an individual certificate or  
printed information setting forth in summary form  
a statement of the essential features of the in-  
surance coverage of such employee or such member;  
~~to-whom-the-benefits-thereunder-are-payable;~~ and  
in substance the provisions of sections 2821 to  
2828.'
