COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1387, L.D. 1692, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Off-duty Court Appearances by State Police
Officers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Concerning Off-duty Court Appearances by Law Enforcement Officers.'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the 4th line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "All state" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking out the following: "All municipal police officers and state police officers" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'All-municipal-police-officers Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, all law enforcement officers'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 5 (section 6 in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the Fiscal Note and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Fiscal Note

The costs will be reimbursed from the District Court and the county.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment extends the payment for off-duty court appearances to all law enforcement officers.
