IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT to Exempt Mobile Homes from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 35 is enacted to read:

35. **Mobile homes.** Retail sales of any mobile home used as a residence.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that passage of this bill will result in a loss of revenue to the State of \$950,000 for the first year of the biennium and \$1,250,000 for the 2nd year of the biennium.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will exempt from the sales tax retail sales of any mobile home which is used as a residence.
