COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1377, L.D. 1708, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Renovate Indian Dwellings on the Penobscot Indian Reservation."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof the following: "AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Move an Indian Dwelling on the Penobscot Indian Reservation."

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Indian Affairs the sum of \$7,000 to be expended to move a dwelling on the Penobscot Indian Reservation. The breakdown shall be as follows:

1975-76

INDIAN AFFAIRS, DEPARTMENT OF

Capital Construction	\$7,000
----------------------	---------

The funds shall be used only to move the house and regrade the lot. Any balance of funds not expended shall lapse.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will provide \$7,000 to correct the problem caused by the construction of the new Community Building at Indian Island, Old Town.
