## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Renovate Indian Dwellings on the Penobscot Indian Reservation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Penobscot Tribal Governor and Council the sum of \$258,979 to be expended on the improvement and renovation of Indian dwellings on the Penobscot Indian Reservation. The breakdown is as follows:

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

At the present time, 78% of the dwellings surveyed by the Penobscot Indian Community Action Program on the Penobscot Indian Reservation have been found to be substandard according to federal guidelines established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development. This bill is intended to make Penobscot Indian Housing conform to federal legislation and to improve present day living conditions.
