STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Directing the Department of Transportation to Authorize Access from U. S. Route 1 to an Industrial Park in the Town of Woolwich.

Department of Transportation; directed to authorize access from U.S. Route 1. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation is directed, subject to approval of the Federal Highway Administration, to authorize access from U.S. Route 1 in the Town of Woolwich to a proposed industrial park. The construction of the access road, including all necessary appurtenances as may be prescribed by the Department of Transportation, shall be at the responsibility of the developer. All work activities within the right-of-way limits of the state highway shall be subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation or as said department may direct. The Department of Transportation shall be relieved of any liability incurred as a result of said access.

FISCAL NOTE

Any costs incurred shall be at the expense of the developer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to allow access from a section of controlled access highway in the Town of Woolwich.
