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**STATE OF MAINE**

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED  
SEVENTY-FIVE**

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**AN ACT to Establish a Restaurant Concession at the Ancient Pemaquid  
Restoration Site in the Town of Bristol.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 802 is enacted to read:

§ 802. **Restaurant facilities at the Ancient Pemaquid Restoration  
Site in the Town of Bristol**

Acting under the authority granted in section 602, subsection 4, the Bureau of Parks and Recreation shall establish and lease to a private corporation a restaurant concession at the Ancient Pemaquid Restoration Site in the Town of Bristol under terms and conditions which further the public use of that restaurant and are compatible with the purposes and uses of that park. Moneys derived from that concession shall be paid into the General Fund.

**FISCAL NOTE**

State revenue derived from the restaurant concession established under this bill will be minimal.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill establishes a restaurant concession at the Ancient Pemaquid Restoration Site in the Town of Bristol.
