COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1450, L.D. 1721,
Bill, "AN ACT to Equalize the Offset of Workmen's Compensation
Benefits Against Certain Retirement and Social Security
Benefits."

Amend said Bill in the 7th line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "62" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '60'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 5 by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following new sentence: 'There shall be no offset for any person who has attained age 60, whether such attainment occurs before or after the injury which subsequently entitles the person to amounts under workmen's compensation or similar law.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of these amendments are:

- 1. To change the age for application of the setoff to persons under age 60 to reflect the fact that state employees may retire at that age rather than 62.
- 2. To provide to persons who choose to work past age 60 the same protection as is given to those who retire at age 60.
