STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Form of Referendum Question to be Voted on by the People.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- I MRSA § 31 is enacted to read:
- § 31. Form of referendum question

Whenever a referendum question is used for the purpose of referring any matter for approval or rejection by vote of the people, the question shall be worded in such manner that a "yes" vote shall signify approval of the measure itself and a "no" vote shall signify rejection of such measure.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to prevent possible misunderstanding in the approval and rejection of matters referred by referendum for vote of the people.
