COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1454, L.D. 1729, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Workmen's Compensation Benefits for
Injured Employees with Insolvent, Inadequately Insured or
Uninsured Employers."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'39 MRSA §57, last ¶, as last amended by PL 1969, c. 90, is further amended to read:

In every case of the death of an employee under this Act where there is no person entitled to compensation, the employer shall pay to the Industrial Accident Commission the a sum equal to 100 times the average weekly wage in the State of Maine as computed by the Employment Security Commission of-\$1,500, to be deposited with the Treasurer of State for the benefit of said fund, and the commission shall direct the distribution thereof.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike those parts of L.D. 1729 which create a new "Workmen's Compensation Special Fund" but to retain the substance of paragraph A of subsection 1 of the L.D.
