HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1491, L.D. 1739, Bill, "AN ACT to Restrict Armed Forces Preferences in State Employment to Veterans Who Were Not Career Officers or Career Enlisted Personnel and to Remove a Barrier to Affirmative Action Programs."

Amend said amendment by adding a new sentence at the end of section 3 as follows:

'However, a veteran who is receiving a disability pension shall be entitled to preference points under the last sentence notwithstanding his previous employment in the classified service after obtaining such preference points.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that any veteran receiving preference points may use them in applying for a position in the state service notwithstanding the fact that he has been previously employed in the classified service after obtaining those preference points.
