STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Hunting Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 2355-A, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 257, § 1, is further amended to read:

There shall be a closed season on bear from the first Monday following Thanksgiving to ~~May~~ June 1st of the next calendar year.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 2355-A, 2nd ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 257, § 2, is further amended to read:

It shall be unlawful to trap bear in the State from December 31st to ~~May~~ June 1st of the next calendar year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to provide protection for mother and cubs until June 1st instead of May as presently provided.
