

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE (Filing No. H-664)

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1228, L.D. 1754, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Citizen Woodcutting Act."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first raragraph.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:'

Further amend said Amendment in that part designated "<u>\$1801.</u>" in the 4th line by striking out the underlined words "<u>citizens with low incomes</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words '<u>Maine citizens</u>' and in the last line by striking out the underlined words "<u>low-income</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word '<u>Maine</u>'

Further amend said Amendment in that part designated "\$1802." by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of that part designated "<u>§1803.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§1803. Definitions

As used in this chapter, "family" means a unit consisting of a head of a household, that head's spouse, if any, and his or their children, if any.' HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\beta$ " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to HP 1228, L.D. 1754 -2-

Further amend said 1 in that part designated "<u>\$1804.</u>" by striking out all of paragraph A and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Such permits or contracts shall be issued only to <u>a Maine citizen comprising a</u> families whose head is a Maine resident or to/singlemember household. A permit or contract with a singlemember household or a family shall limit the amount of wood which a single member household or a family is authorized to cut under this chapter to 2 cords per year.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to meet the energy needs of Maine people. Since most forestland is in the jurisdiction of the Department of Conservation, the commissioner is directed to do the bulk of the planning and coordination. This amendment also removes the emergency preamble

from the bill.
