HOUSE AMENDMENT "D " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to
S.P. 480, L.D. 1760, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Amendment on page 13 by inserting after
section 26-B the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 32
the following:

'Sec. 32-A. 22 MRSA §6110, last paragraph, as last
repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 523, section 1, is
amended to read:

Any expenditure of funds for family day care shall not
cause the amount which may be expended for/^{other types of}developmental
day care or any other type of service to decrease below the
cumulative fiscal year to date amount expended as of April 1,
1975 for such other types of developmental day care or such
other type of service.

Sec. 32-B. Effective date. Section 32-A of this Act
shall take effect 91 days after adjournment of the legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of L.D. 1500 was to include "family day care"
as one type of "developmental day care." Section 1 of chapter
523 mistakenly indicated that family day care was not a type
of developmental day care. This amendment corrects that
mistake.

The Judiciary Committee voted to include this amendment in
the committee amendment but could not because L.D. 1500 was not

a chaptered law when the committee amendment was prepared and thus could not be amended. The Judiciary Committee supports this House Amendment to the errors and inconsistencies bill.
