HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 480, L.D. 1760, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§402-A." in subsection 3 in the 3rd line by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", except public officials involved in the legislative process,"

Further amend said Amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§402-A." by inserting at the end the following:

'4.Legislative records and reports. Records, working and intraoffice papers, interoffice / memoranda used or maintained by any legislator, legislative agency or legislative employee to prepare proposed Senate or House papers or reports for consideration by the Legislature or any of its committees during the biennium in which such proposal or report is prepared.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the definition of "public record" to preserve the previously expressed intent of the Legislature concerning materials used to prepare legislation for introduction.
