SENATE AMENDMENT "E " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 480,  
L.D. 1760, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies  
in the Public Laws."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of section 18-D.

Further amend said Amendment by striking out the underlined  
abbreviation and figure "Sec. 18-E." and inserting in place thereof  
the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 18-D.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after section 18-E  
the following:

'Sec. 18-E. 17 MRSA §1609-A, sub-§1, last ¶, as repealed  
and replaced by PL 1973, c. 178, is repealed and the following  
enacted in place thereof:

and also shall enter on any form prescribed by the  
Secretary of State, Division of Motor Vehicles the information  
required by this section. Any person, firm, partnership or corporation  
who intentionally violates any provision of this subsection shall  
be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment  
for not more than 11 months, or by both.'
