HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S. P. 480, L.D. 1760, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public
Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 36 the following:

'Sec. 36-A. 26 MRSA §135, first ¶, as enacted by

PL 1975, c. 176, is amended to read:

Each article covered by this subchapter shall bear a plainly visible tag or be contained in a bag or box upon which shall be indelibly stamped or printed, in English, the name of the and manufacturer or vendor, a statement showing the kind of materials used in filling such article and-with-approximate-percentages when-mixed.

Sec. 36-B. Effective date. Section 36-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove language which raises a question of unconstitutionality.
