## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 107TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 480, L.D. 1760, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public
Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 27 the following:

'Sec. 27-A. 22 MRSA §2204-E, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 257, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

## §2204-E. Exceptions

Advertising as described in section 2204-D shall be permitted except that:

- 1. No advertising of any drugs included in the Comprehensive

  Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Act of 1970, 84 Stat.

  1236, shall be permitted; and
- 2. No advertising of hypodermic needles and hypodermic syringes shall be permitted.

Sec. 27-B. Effective date. Section 27-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
