SENATE AMENDMENT " &" to H.P. 1137, L.D. 1766, Bill,
"AN ACT to Regulate Business Practices Between Motor Vehicle
Manufacturers, Distributors and Dealers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 of that part designated "§1173." and renumbering subsection 2 to be subsection 1.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in subsection 3 of that part designated "§1174." all of paragraph L.

Further amend said Bill in subsection 3 of that part designated " $\S1174$ ." by striking out in the first line of paragraph M the following: "M" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'L'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd sentence of that part designated "§1175." and inserting in place thereof the following: 'The delivery and preparation obligations of its motor vehicle dealers and a schedule of the compensation to be paid to its motor vehicle dealers for the work and services they shall be required to perform in connection with such delivery and preparation obligations shall constitute any such dealer's only responsibility for product liability as between such dealer and such manufacturer.'

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SENATE AMENDMENT " B" to H.P. 1137, L.D. 1766

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Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "\$1182."

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the bill to read consecutively.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to strike from the bill those provisions which mandate the office of the Attorney General to enforce this Act so that no appropriation is necessary for this legislation. The amendment also removes a possible unconstitutional provision from the bill.
