Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the 2nd sentence of that part designated "§2462." the following underlined words: "large numbers of"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2463." by striking out twice in the first line of subsection 2 the underlined words "or staff" (same in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2463." by striking out in the 2nd line of subsection 2 (same in L.D.) the underlined words "or faculty member"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2463." by striking out in the last line of subsection 2 (same in L.D.) the underlined words "need not" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'shall'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2464." by striking out in the 9th line (8th line of L.D.) the underlined words "and staff"
