COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1458, L.D. 1785, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish the Maine Vocational Development
Commission."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§1263." in the 3rd and 4th lines (3rd line in L.D.) by
striking out the underlined words "Director of the Bureau of
the Department
Vocational Education in/ and inserting in place thereof the
underlined words 'Commissioner'.

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§1267." by striking out in the 2nd line (same in L.D.)
the underlined word "the" and inserting in place thereof
the underlined word 'an'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§1267." by inserting at the end the following:
'No funds shall be expended for the purpose of establishing
specific training programs prior to approval by the commission
of an agreement which ensures additional jobs for Maine residents.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the procedures to be followed
prior to the expenditure of any funds. Agreements describing
specific training programs must be approved by the commission
before these programs may be established. No funds may be

spent for establishing these programs until the commission has approved the agreements. This amendment also provides that the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services shall serve on the commission instead of the Director of the Bureau of Vocational Education.
