HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1198, L.D. 1786, Bill, "AN ACT
to Incorporate Howland Water District."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 10 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 10. Property tax exempt. The property of said district
the Revised Statutes of 1964,
shall be exempt from taxation as provided in/Title 36, section 651.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the provisions of
the Act comply with the general law on exemptions for quasi-municipal
corporations.
