SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1401, L.D. 1787, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the Uniform Crime Victim's Reparations Act."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

<u>'Sec. 2.</u> Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Criminal Victim Reimbursement Board the sum of \$50,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

'Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1976.'
