SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 1401, L.D. 1787, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish the
Uniform Crime Victim's Reparations Act."

Amend said Amendment in section 1 by inserting at the
end the following:

'§4218. Funds

The board shall be authorized to accept and administer
according to law loans, grants or other funds or gifts from
the Federal Government and from other sources, public or
private, for carrying out its functions under this chapter.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of
section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
the General Fund to the Criminal Victim Reimbursement Board
the sum of \$50,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
The breakdown shall be as follows:

Further amend said Amendment by adding at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become
effective July 1, 1976.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to postpone the effective date of this Act until July 1, 1976, to reduce funding accordingly and to provide for receipt and utilization of federal funds.
