"AN ACT to Amend the Human Rights Act to Prevent Discrimination

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 2."

by striking out in the 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th lines

of subsection 7-A after the underlined word and punctuation "illness;"

the following: "and shall include, but is not limited to; epilepsy
seizure disorders; any degree of paralysis; cerebral palsy, autism;

mental retardation; amputation; lack of physical function or

coordination; impairment of sight, hearing or speech; or physical
reliance on a seeing eye dog, wheelchair or other remedial

appliance or device;" (4th, 5th, 6th 7th and 8th lines of L.D.)

It is felt unnecessary to spell out some of the conditions and not all of them.
