HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1390, L.D. 1798, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Potato Tax and the Maine Potato Commission."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 6-A. 36 MRSA \$4569, 2nd sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1971, c. 428, \$4, is amended to read:

At the time of filing said report, each shipper shall pay to the State Tax Assessor a tax at the rate of \$7012 \$.025 per hundredweight upon all potatoes so reported as purchased, sold or shipped.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to correct a technical error in the committee amendment. The increase in the potato tax in the committee amendment did not change the previous lower tax in all sections of the original bill.
