COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1158, L.D. 1812,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Implement the Recommendations of the Maine  
Traffic Court Advisory Committee."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 4, 5, 6,  
9, 10, 11 and 12.

Further amend said Bill in section 16 by striking out  
all of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

~~'Nothing-in-this-section-shall-be-interpreted-to-prohibit  
a-court-from-filing-a-case-upon-payment-of-costs-without-a  
conviction-'~~

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of  
section 27-B.

Further amend said Bill in section 60 in that part  
designated "§2300." in subsection 1 by striking out in the  
3rd line the underlined word "substantially" (same in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill in section 61  
K—in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) by striking out the  
underlined words "for which trial by jury has been waived"

Further amend said Bill in section 63 in that part  
designated "§2303." in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (same  
in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$500"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure  
'\$250'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections  
to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to delete provisions from the bill being amended that are either already law or are included in other legislation, for clarification and to reduce the amount of the maximum general penalty provided in the bill being amended from \$500 to \$250.
