

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1425, L.D. 1817, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2 and 3.

Further amend said Bill in section 15 in that part designated "<u>§2454.</u>" by striking out in the 5th line (4th line of L.D.) the stricken out word "highway" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'highway or'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 17 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'<u>Sec. 17. 12 MRSA §2455</u>, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 625, §78, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

Any person convicted of hunting wild animals between sunset and 1/2 hour after sunset, during the open season on deer, shall be subject to the penalties as provided in section 3060.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 19 and 20-A.

Further amend said Bill in section 21 by inserting in the 2nd line after the amending clause (first line of L.D.) after the underlined word "<u>any</u>" the underlined words '<u>whole or</u> any part of any'

Further amend said Bill in section 21 by striking out in the 2nd line after the amending clause (same in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation ", fish or parts thereof" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'or fish' Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the

Statement of Fact the following:

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 1425, L.D. 1817 P. 2

'Sec. 24. P&SL 1963, c. 44 is repealed.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3-A to 4-A to be sections 1 to 4.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering section 20 to be section 19.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 20-B to 20-E to be sections 20, 20-A, 20-B and 20-C.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes unnecessary sections of the Bill (1, 2, 3, 19 and 20-A.) and clarifies the language in sections 15, 17 and 21.
