CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1510, L.D. 1827  
RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Provide  
for Annual Sessions of the Legislature and to Change the Date of  
Convening of the Legislature

Amend said Resolution by inserting after the first  
sentence of the 1st paragraph of that part relating to  
Section 1 of Pt. 3, Art. IV of the Constitution, the following  
underlined sentence:

'The Legislature shall enact appropriate statutory limits on the  
length of the first regular session and of the second regular  
session.'

Statement of Fact

This Conference Committee amendment provides that the  
Legislature shall, by statute, set limits to the length of the  
first and second regular sessions established by the resolution.
