HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1510, L.D. 1827, RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Provide for Annual  
Sessions of the Legislature and to Change the Date of Convening  
of the Legislature.

Amend said Resolution in that part amending the Constitution,  
Article IV, Part 3, Section 1 by inserting at the end the following  
new sentence:

'The Legislature shall convene on the first Wednesday after  
the first Tuesday of January, 1976, for what shall be deemed  
to be the second regular session of the 107th Legislature.'
