SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1510, L.D. 1827, RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Provide for Annual Sessions of the Legislature and to Change the Date of Convening of the Legislature.

Amend said Resolution in that part designated "Constitution, Art. IV, Pt. 3, §1" by striking out all of the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Legislature shall convene on the first Wednesday of January ~~biennially~~ and following the general election in what shall be styled the first regular session of the Legislature, which shall last no longer than one hundred legislative days and shall further convene on the first Wednesday of January in the subsequent year in what shall be styled the second regular session of the Legislature, which shall last no longer than fifty legislative days; provided, however, that the business of the second regular session of the Legislature shall be limited to budgetary matters, legislation in the Governor's message, legislation recommended by the Legislative Council and legislation referred to committees for study and report by the first regular session.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit the length of regular legislative sessions.
